




Christmas Eve Sunday, December 24, 2023 10 a.m.

LIGHTING OF THE CHRIST CANDLE

Today we light the Christ Candle to celebrate the birth of the Baby Jesus.

One: Come to the manger with joy and with wonder,

All: Jesus is born; this tiny, fragile baby.

One: We have waited a long time for this moment.

All: We have marked each week with a reminder of what we wait for.

One: First, was hope. Even in the face of all that is wrong, we see the face of hope tonight.

All: We light the candle of hope, and it illuminates God's promise that light is greater than darkness.

One: Next, was peace. Even in the face of violence and fear, we see the face of peace tonight.

All: We light the candle of peace, and it proclaims God's justice when we will make war no more.

One: Then, was joy. Even in the face of despair and sorrow, we see the face of joy tonight.

All: We light the candle of joy, and it shows us God's healing and wholeness.

One: Today we celebrate that love has come down to us, to be with us, always.

All: This love has a face. We call him Jesus, Emmanuel, God with us.

One: We light the candle of love, and its light leads us in God's ways. We see the face of love tonight.

All: And, finally, we light the Christ Candle, and it declares that God is here among us now. We see the baby's face.

One: Come to the manger with joy and with wonder!

All: Jesus is born! Glory to God in the highest!


